



2018-2019 Season Heritage Classes

Regional Heritage Cup - New Competition Details

This competition is for older type horses – they can be clipped but **NOT** razored and can be shown and presented in the same manner at standard halter classes.

Rules:

Members in all four NZMHA regions will compete for their regional trophy.

\$5 entry fee for the season – form must be completed and sent to the Heritage Competition Co-ordinator. Lanyard will be issued to identify Heritage Horses and must be worn in ALL classes. Card must be filled in and returned at the end of the season for the points to be counted.

Horses can either enter the heritage classes or the standard halter classes but **NOT BOTH** i.e. once a horse shows in the heritage classes it remains in the heritage classes ALL season. But you can still enter other NZMHA classes for best presented, showmanship, head and all performance.

Horses must be NZMHA Registered and have a valid NZMHA height certificate.

Heritage halter classes are:

Young Stock	1 year and under; fillies, geldings, and colts in the same class
Junior	2-3 Years; mares, geldings and stallions in the same class
Senior	4 Years and over; mares, geldings and stallions in the same class
Classes for heritage horses	Colour and movement.

Points accumulated as follows:

Points count for one halter class, one colour class and one performance class per show. (Trail or Jumping only) Jumping at novice heights

1 st	5
2 nd	4
3 rd	3
4 th	2
5 th	1

Shows to count – 8 total shows count – made up of club shows and one showcase show.
