The New Zealand Miniature Horse National Show will be run in accordance with NZMHA's Official Show Rule Booklet 2017/2018 and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Please read these rules carefully to make sure you are eligible and meet criteria to enter each class.

Registration Upgrades

Please make sure you have all your upgrades up to date as entries will be refused if this is not complied with.

No entries will be accepted with registrations "pending".

Camping

Camping is permitted on the show grounds for:

\$20.00 Day unpowered per site Max of 4 people per site

If you do intend to camp on the grounds please indicate number of campers on the Entry Supplement and forward payment with your show entries.

Photographer

A photographer will be at the show.

The Youth Auction will be held on Friday night along with a sausage sizzle with all proceeds from the auction going toward the NZMHA Youth, this will all get put into their own account.

Measuring

It is a requirement of the National Show Rules that all foals and yearlings are to be height verified at the show.

All measuring will be at allocated times only. – includes height verification for foals and yearlings.

Performance Cards

It will be mandatory for all those horses and handlers entering Novice classes to provide a copy of their performance cards **with their show entry**. Please make sure your horse's novice status is updated prior to the show as well as Handler cards. If you do not have a Handler card, you may get one from your Regional Delegate or the Show Convener. Although this show is zero rated for Hi Points we do require proof of you or your horse's novice status.

JUDGING SYSTEM - Placings are to 5th place.

The New Zealand Miniature Horse National Show will have 3 judges who will judge the classes and an accumulated points system will be utilised. Horses placed under each judge will receive the following points:

1st Place – 8 points	3rd Place – 6 points	5th Place – 4 points	7th Place – 2 points
2nd Place – 7 points	4th Place – 5 points	6th Place – 3 points	8th Place – 1 point

Points earned by each horse from all judges will be added together to be the total score. The call judge's placing will be used to break all ties.

Using the accumulated point system, placings will be the National Champion, National Reserve Champion and 3rd, 4th, 5th. The National Champion and National Reserve Champion will return for the National Grand Champion and Reserve National Grand Champion, top 3rd, top 4th and top 5th.

For performance classes that are judged on scores, each judge will place the National Champion, Reserve National Champion, top 3rd, top 4th and top 5th places.

The scores from these classes will determine the National Grand Champion and the Reserve National Grand Champion, top 3rd, top 4th and top 5th.

For performance classes and showmanship classes that are judged on scores, each judge will place the top eight horses or handlers in the order of their scores. The below points system will then be utilized to determine the placings.

National Grand Champion: 5 pts

Reserve National Grand Champion: 4 pts

3rd: 3 pts

4th: 2 pts

5th: 1 pt

National Grand Champion will be awarded one more point than the Reserve National Grand Champion and so on to 5th place in the National Grand Champion results.

The points gained from these classes will then be added together for use in the Supreme performance horse and for the performance part of the over-all horse.

Supreme Performance Horse

Classes to be counted: Jumping – one jumping class either hunter or jumper
Trail
Harness – one harness class either Country or Single Pleasure, or Roadster

Scoring:

1st = 4pts
2nd = 3 pts
3rd = 2 pts
4th = 1 pt

Champion = 4 pts
Reserve Champ = 3 pts

Points will be scaled in accordance with the NZMHA Hi Points rules.

Must be present for awarding ribbons.

ALL ROUND AWARDS

The following points system will apply to:

New Zealand National Grand Champion Performance Horse – Cat A and Cat B

New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Horse – Cat A and Cat B

New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Junior Youth

New Zealand National Champion Best All Round Senior Youth

1st place = 5 points
2nd place = 4 points
3rd place = 3 points
4th place = 2 points
5th place = 1 point

In the event of a tie the following count back will apply: most 1sts, followed by most 2nds etc down to 5th place.

Points will be scaled in accordance with NZMHA Hi Point rules.

Youth All Round Awards: Points counted from Youth classes only

HUNTER AND TRAIL CLASSES

Please note that the open and novice classes for Trail and Hunter at the NZMHA National Show be run continuously and the ribbons be awarded at the completion of the open and novice classes.

SWEEPSTAKE CLASSES

Category A and Category B are separate classes. Open to any age or sex within that category. Classes will be judged using the normal halter workout of the day.

All entry fee sweepstakes money and sponsorship moneys will be paid out to the Top 10 horses in each category.

1st place 25%
2nd place 20%
3rd place 15%
4th place 10%
5th to 10th places 5%

ENTRY AND REGISTRATION RULES

The New Zealand Miniature Horse National Show is open to any horse registered with NZMHA which is owned and shown by a current financial member of NZMHA. Note: For a non-NZMHA member to handle

horses at the show they must be registered (Handler Registration) with NZMHA BEFORE the close of entry for the show.

Handlers - Minimum age to compete is 5 years of age.

A copy of the horse's current NZMHA height certificate and both sides of their registration certificate must be attached. Entry is deemed to be incomplete and may be refused if copies of these certificates are not enclosed. Where applicable, copies of NZMHA leases must also be provided at time of entry.

REFUNDS

No refund will be given without a current veterinarian certificate. Only 70% of entry fees will be refunded. This certificate must be received by the show manager prior to the commencement of the first class of the show.

Stabling fees will be refunded in full if stables are reallocated by show management.

MEASURING OF HORSES

Measuring will be available at the show at allocated times only. There will be no measuring outside of the allocated times. Please complete the measuring form and attach with your entries.

There will be a charge of **\$20.00 (GST Inc.) per Horse**. The charge for **Foals is \$5.00**.

Please try and get your horses measured before this show - contact your NZMHA Regional Delegate for measuring information.

Please note the new Height Verification required for foals and yearlings. Times for Height Verification will be available via the NZMHA website prior to the show.

HOLDING AREA

IMPORTANT: Horses will be called into the arena to be presented for judging in order of back numbers. To ensure the smooth running of the show Competitors must be in the collection area within 3 minutes of the last Competitor of the previous class entering the show ring. The gate steward will exclude late Competitors from competition in that class. This includes Champions and Supremes. Horses from the class immediately preceding are excluded from this requirement. The gate steward must be informed if a halter break is required, or the gate will not be held.

GENERAL

BACK NUMBERS ARE TO BE WORN ON THE BACK - ENTER THE RING IN BACK NUMBER ORDER

Once entered, no changes may be made to entries except under the following circumstances:

- horses entered as Category A and measured in excess of Height for Age for Category A prior to the judging of the first class on the first day of competition will be moved to the corresponding classes in Category B;
- where the horse entered for handler-related classes (best presented/showmanship/whip) is scratched from the Shows prior to the first class on the first day of competition another horse (already catalogued) may be substituted;
- horses/exhibitors entered in Novice classes who upgrade to Open prior to the Show will be moved to Open.
- Novice Handlers and Novice Horses - Cards are required to be lodged with Show Management prior to competition.

The organisers reserve the right to split/combine/cancel classes where entries warrant it

**All horses including foals must have a current NZMHA
Height Certificate in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules**

NOTE: - Height Certificates must be NO OLDER THAN 45 days for Yearlings and Foals

STABLING & PENS

A limited number of stables are available and will be priority allocated to Stallions and Foals, then any veterinary requirements. Every endeavour will be made to accommodate exhibitors to their best convenience. All Stallions must be stabled.

Stables:

\$ 25.00 per box– per night \$50 long stay (2 nights or more)

Note:

- Nominate Stable Requirements on Entry Form
- Please ensure you clean out stables/pens before departure;
- A **penalty of \$100.00 will** be charged for each un-cleaned box;
- Please keep the stable area clean at all times by picking up all horse manure and rubbish after you
- Please do not leave your horses tied up and left unattended outside the stables/yards.

CATERING

Professional catering will be available on site all four days

ERRORS & OMISSIONS

Should there be a conflict between this schedule and the NZMHA Show Rules or Constitution then this schedule shall not prevail. Please bring any such error or omission to the attention of the show organisers so that it can be rectified.

DISCLAIMER

All horses, exhibitors and spectators enter the grounds at their own risk. The organisers and associated people/organisations are not responsible for any damage, injury or loss that may occur.

Whilst every care has been taken to ensure the safety of the grounds and equipment the responsibility for ensuring individual safety of persons and property rests with the owner and the exhibitor/guardian, and NZMHA will not be held liable for any loss or injury incurred. By entering the show the owner and/or exhibitor/guardian indemnifies NZMHA, the NZMHA Council and the Show Staff from any/all liability for damage/injury caused as a result of the owner and/or exhibitor/guardian or their horse's actions or inactions.

All Youth under 18 years, whether they are competing or not are to be under direct adult supervision whilst on the Show Grounds.

DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED anywhere on the grounds.

Notice

Conduct of a member, an exhibitor, trainer, owner or spectator of an unsportsmanlike, abusive, or detrimental nature will not be tolerated by the show management: including but not limited to threatening, abusive or intimidating conduct (physical, verbal or written) towards any show official, fellow exhibitor or any other person.

Any person(s) guilty of such conduct should be reported immediately to the Show Management. Show Management reserves the right to request the person(s) concerned to leave the show and the show venue.

New – ‘Novice Handler’ Award – Paid Entry

At the conclusion of the classes each day we will be awarding the ‘**Novice Handler Award**’ sash

This will be calculated from placings in (4 top placings in any of the following classes)

- ❑ Conformation, Colour, Head, Movement, 1 x Jumping - novice or open, 1 x Trail - novice or open, 1 x Harness either Single pleasure or Country Pleasure or Roaster. (no handler classes count)

Scoring will be scaled - No youth Classes are included.

Can you please remain present if you are entered for this award.

- ❑ Open to horses which have not been trained and/or owned by a professional trainer/handler since 1st September 2017. (For the purpose of this competition a ‘Professional’ is deemed to be a person who has received remuneration by way of money, services or products in return for them having supplied any person/business with their services/expertise as a horse handler/trainer on a ‘consistent basis’.
- ❑ Handler is not to have previously won more than 3 Supreme or Runner Up Supremes (in halter) at any NZMHA Show prior to 1st September 2017. Wins apply only if the ‘entrant’ showed their own horse/or that of an immediate family member in its halter class then in the Supreme line up. ‘Handling/showing’ a horse for the sole purpose of assisting in a Supreme Line up does not count as a win.

- ❑ Same Handler must show horse in all classes
