Recommended Minimum Schedule for A & P Show

Horses must be registered with bodies affiliated to the RAS. Registration number and Association must be stated on Entry Form. Horses or ponies registered with any other breed society are not eligible. The Miniature Horse section of the show will be run in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules.
