Rules and Conditions:

- All Owners and Competitors must be Current Financial NZMHA members and all Handlers must be Current Registered NZMHA Handlers to be able to enter the ring.
- Only entries from NZMHA Registered Miniature Horses will be accepted.
- Where a horse is leased, a copy of the lease must also be included with entries
- All horses entered must have a valid NZMHA Height Certificate at the time of showing. A copy of the current height certificate is to be included with entries. Failure to provide a copy of the height certificate may result in your entries not being accepted.
- Stud names are not to be used for entries.
- No dogs on the grounds.
- 70% of your entry fees will be refunded upon the receipt of a vet or medical certificate.
- The NZMHA (Inc) reserves the right to combine, alter or delete classes as they see fit. Hi-Point, Youth Hi-Point, Gelding Incentive and Mare Incentive classes cannot be combined, altered or deleted.
- The NZMHA (Inc) has the right to remove any horse that is dangerous or person that is behaving badly.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- The Privacy Act. All competitor's names and addresses will be held by the NZMHA (Inc) and may be used to publish results unless otherwise advised.
- This show is run under NZMHA Show Rules.
- Best Presented, Showmanship, Youth Showmanship and all Youth Hi-Point classes MUST HAVE name of handler. If names of handlers are NOT specified exhibitor will not be able to enter the ring. Registered Handlers are not eligible to enter these classes – you must be a financial member.
- Horses may enter in either Novice or Open – NOT BOTH Performance cards must be handed in at the start of the show for Novice Horses.
- Please be on time for your classes – once the class has been called into the ring, the steward will refuse admission to latecomers.
- Exhibitors will not be admitted in classes that are not specified on their entry form.
- Back numbers must be worn on the back and exhibitors must enter in back number order unless agreed otherwise.
- Horses must be physically 36 months of age to be able to enter harness and jumping classes, and 24months of age to be able to enter trail classes.
- Any protest must be made in writing to the Show Manager no later than 1/2 hour after the alleged incident. Forms can be obtained from the show manager on the day. The protest shall be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee in cash, which shall be returned to the protestor in the event the protest is sustained. If the protest is not sustained the fee shall be forfeited. Protest Committee will be advised on the catalogue.
- A Rule Check Timeout Exhibitors have 15 mins from infraction to lodge the form, the show will stop for upto 15 mins while the ruling is clarified and a decision is made

- Electronic or similar devices will not be tolerated in the ring and using them will result in disqualification – no exceptions.
- Age Definitions: **Junior Youth:** Handler 12 years and under at 1 August
Senior Youth: Handler 13 years and over, but under 18 at 1 August
Adult: Handler 18 years and over.
- Errors and Omissions: Should there be a conflict between this schedule and the NZMHA Show Rules or Constitution then this schedule shall not prevail. Please bring any such error or omission to the attention of the show organizers so that it can be rectified.
- General: All persons enter this show at their own risk. NZMHA (Inc) and the Affiliated Club take no responsibility for any injury or any damage to people or property.

Category A:

- ❖ No Cat A horse shall exceed 34"
- ❖ Foals/weanlings must not exceed 30" and with an actual age of between 2-4 months not to measure 29" or over.
- ❖ Yearlings must not exceed 32"
- ❖ Two-year-olds must not exceed 33"

Category B:

- ❖ No Cat B horse shall exceed 38"
- ❖ Foals/weanlings must not exceed 33"
- ❖ Foals/weanlings with actual age of between 2 and 4 months not to be less than 28"
- ❖ Foals/weanlings with actual age of 5 months or greater not to be less than 29"
- ❖ Yearlings must be over 31" but not exceed 36"
- ❖ Two-year-olds must be over 32" inches but not exceed 37"
- ❖ Horses three years and older must be over 33"

Height Certificates to be no older than:

- ❖ 45 days for foals and yearlings
- ❖ 3 months for 2-year-olds
- ❖ 6 months for 3 years and 4 years
- ❖ 12 months for 5 years and over
- ❖ Please note there will be no measuring available at the show unless prior arrangement is made with the Regional Delegate. Cost of measuring at the show is \$20 per horse.
- ❖ If you are unable to get your horse to a measuring day prior to entries closing, but will be measured before the show, please advise on your entry form - your valid height certificate **MUST** be presented when you pick up your back numbers – failure to do so will mean you will not be able to show.

Supreme Performance Horse

Classes to be counted: Jumping – One jumping class either Hunter or Jumper, Trail, Harness – One Harness class either Country Pleasure, Single Pleasure or Roadster

Scoring: Points will be scaled

1st = 4pts, 2nd = 3 pts, 3rd = 2 pts, 4th = 1 pt

Champion = 4 pts

Reserve Champ = 3 pts

- ❖ If a draw in points occurs for Supreme Performance Horse, then a count back on Champions, then reserves etc. will decide the winner.

NZ Bred Horse

- ❖ The horses eligible to be shown in these classes are determined as follows:
Sire and Dam are both to have been bred and born in NZ (not in utero)
- ❖ If more than 8 horses in a class then the class will be split into their appropriate genders: i.e., fillies/mares, geldings and colts/stallions.
- ❖ Placings will be as follows: - Champion, Reserve Champion, 3rd 4th

Champions only then come in for NZ Bred Champion of Champions
