# Conditions of Entry:

- Entries must be accompanied by a photocopy (or PDF if emailed) of both sides of the current height certificate, if the horse is leased then a copy of the NZMHA lease agreement must accompany the entry.
- Horses must be currently registered with NZMHA and have a valid NZMHA height certificate unless being measured at this show
- The show will run in accordance with NZMHA Show Rules.
- NZMHA Height for Age applies. **PLEASE NOTE:**

## **Category A:**

No Cat A horse shall exceed 34"

Foals/weanlings must not exceed 30" and with an actual age of between 2-4 months not to measure 29" or over.

Yearlings must not exceed 32"

Two year olds must not exceed 33"

## **Category B:**

No Cat B horse shall exceed 38"

Foals/weanlings must not exceed 33"

Foals/weanlings with actual age of between 2 and 4 months not to be less than 28"

Foals/weanlings with actual age of 5 months or greater not to be less than 29"

Yearlings must be over 31" but not exceed 36"

Two year olds must be over 32" inches but not exceed 37"

Horses three years and older must be over 33"

- Certificates to be no older than:  
Horses under three years – 3 months old  
Horses three years and under five years - 6 months,  
Horses five years and over – 12 months old
- Stud names are not to be used for entries
- All exhibitors and spectators must act in an appropriate and sportsmanlike manner, failure to do so may result in you being asked to leave the grounds. Be Kind to one another.
- Show management reserves the right to request the withdrawal of any exhibit it considers dangerous to the public or other exhibitors
- Privacy Act: Show management reserves the right to hold records of names and addresses of all exhibitors and will publish these as necessary for media show reports, unless otherwise advised
- Back numbers must be returned at completion of classes. Failure to return your back number will result in a charge of \$5 per number not returned.
- Please ensure your parking area and pens are left clean with no hay, horse manure or excessive feed. A trailer is on site for MANURE. Please no general rubbish. It is preferred you ask a committee member to check your areas before you leave. Failure to clean areas used may result in a cleaning charge of \$50.
- All exhibitors and spectators enter the grounds at their own risk. The organisers, affiliated club nor NZMHA are responsible for any damage, injury or loss that may occur
- Please be on time for your classes, the gate steward has the right to refuse latecomers entry
- Foals are not permitted to run loose.
- Colts and Stallions must be properly restrained at all times.
- Should there be conflict between the schedule and NZMHA Show Rules or Constitution, then this schedule shall not prevail, please bring any such error or omission to the show organisers attention.
- No refund of entry fees, unless with evidence of a Doctors or Veterinarian's certificate (maximum of 75% of entry fee at committee discretion) no later than 48 hours after show date.
- If the show is cancelled due to covid-19 restrictions. Fees will be refunded less \$10 administration cost.
- Late entries **MAY** incur a late fee. Late entries will be catalogued up to Wednesday 18th November 2020, late entries after this date will not be catalogued.
- All protests must be lodged in writing to the Show Manager no later than one hour after the alleged incident. The protest shall be accompanied by a \$50 fee in cash, which shall be returned to the protester in the event the protest is sustained. If the protest is not sustained the fee shall be forfeited.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the programme and split or combine classes where entries warrant it. Changes will be posted on the day.
